UAHU Urges Molina Healthcare Members to Contact a Health Insurance Agent before December 15th

(Salt Lake City, UT) The Utah Association of Health Underwriters (UAHU) warns Molina Healthcare members that their health coverage is at risk. **They must take action by December 15, 2017**, or they might be without suitable health coverage in 2018. Those without health insurance or an exemption may have to pay a penalty when they file their taxes.

Beginning 2018, Molina will not offer non-Medicare health coverage in Utah. The last day of current Molina coverage is December 31, 2017. Molina plans will be mapped to a similar health plan with a different Utah insurance company. This may not be appropriate for all people. Every Molina subscriber needs to take action by reviewing what options are best for him or her. These individuals must choose a different plan between November 1, 2017 and December 15, 2017.

Molina members need to make sure there isn't a gap in their coverage and avoid paying a penalty by enrolling in a different plan by December 15, 2017. Impacted individuals should contact their licensed insurance agent to guide them through this process.
